

**CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY
ORDINANCE NO. 13-2006**

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE
No. 01-2006 AND ESTABLISHING NO PARKING
ON HIGH STREET FROM THE INTERSECTION OF
US 27 AND HIGH STREET FOR ONE HUNDRED
(100) FEET ON THE EAST AND WEST SIDES
OF HIGH STREET ON MONDAY THRU FRIDAY EXCEPT
HOLIDAYS BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 6:30 A.M.
AND 4:00 P.M.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY AS
FOLLOWS:

Section I

That Ordinance No. 01-2006 is hereby repealed.

Section II

That pursuant to recommendations of the Board of Adjustments and Chief of Police for the
City of Highland Heights, a no parking zone is established on High Street from the Intersection of
US 27 and High Street on the east and west side of High Street for a distance of One Hundred (100)
feet on Monday thru Friday except holidays between the hours of 6:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

Section III

That appropriate signage and yellow painting of the curb shall be installed immediately after
passage of this Ordinance.

Section IV

That the penalty for any persons cited under this Ordinance shall be the same as the penalty
set forth in Section 72.99 of the City's Code of Ordinances. Ten (\$10.00) per violation and an
additional Ten (\$10.00) if fines are not paid within seven (7) days.

Section V

That this ordinance shall be signed by the Mayor, attested by the City Clerk/Treasurer,
recorded and published according to law. Same shall be in effect at the earliest time provided by
law.
