

**CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY
ORDINANCE NO. 07-2007**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION
72.99 OF THE CITY'S PARKING
REGULATIONS IN TITLE SEVEN OF
THE CITY'S TRAFFIC CODE BY INCREASING
THE FINES FOR CERTAIN VIOLATIONS
FROM \$10.00 TO \$25.00.

WHEREAS, the Police Department, Finance Committee, and the City Clerk have researched the viability of increasing fines for city citations, and

WHEREAS, after review by the full city council of the proposed increases

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY:

That Section 72.99 of the City's parking regulations are amended as follows:

Section I

The City Council has established a set procedure for parking control and is set out below in the following procedure.

A.) For the violation of the following items there shall be a fine (Payable to the City and put in the general fund) of ~~\$10.00~~ \$25.00 per violation:

Parking in a No Parking Zone, Firelane, Disabled Parking Place, Fire Plug, Curb (too close-15 feet to far away), Time, Bus Stop, Intersection or any other Hazardous parking. For the violation of any of these regulations in this section (72.99) there shall be a fine (payable to the City and put in the general fund) of \$25.00 per violation.

B.) A penalty of ~~\$10.00~~ \$25.00 shall be imposed if the above fines are not paid within seven (7) working days.

C.) All the law enforcement officers of the city shall have authority to issue the above citations.

Section II

That this Ordinance shall be signed by the Mayor, attested by the City Clerk/Treasurer recorded and published. Same shall be in effect at the earliest time provided by law.
