ORDINANCE NO. 06-2009

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
ORDINANCE NO. 04-96 THE
ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A
SNOW EMERGENCY BY DECREASING
THE NUMBER OF INCHES OF SNOW
REQUIRED TO HAVE FALLEN UPON
THE CITY FROM 4 INCHES TO 3 INCHES
IN A 24 HOUR PERIOD BEFORE
ESTABLISHING A SNOW EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY:

Section I

A new section is added to the Highland Heights traffic code establishing a snow emergency whenever the city has any single accumulation of ~~four (4)~~ three (3) inches or more of snow in a 24 hour period. This designation is in addition to the other snow emergency regulations already in effect in the city.

Section II

That this Ordinance shall be signed by the Mayor, attested by the City Clerk/Treasurer, recorded and published. Same shall be in effect at the earliest time provided by law.

Second reading of this 7 day of April, 2009.
