

CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY

ORDINANCE NO. 03-2000

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE GOALS AND  
POLICIES OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND  
HEIGHTS NEW COMPREHENSIVE PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has conducted several public meetings in preparation of the city's comprehensive plan, and;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Council for the City of Highland Heights has carefully reviewed the goals and policies pertaining to the anticipated comprehensive plan, and;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council for the City of Highland Heights find that the Planning Commission has pursuant to their statutory duty consulted with public officials, agencies, boards of health, school boards, public and private utility companies, civic, educational, professional and other organizations, as well as with the citizens of the City of Highland Heights, and;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council find the statement of goals and policies as set forth by the Planning Commission to be consistent with the direction, they as city leaders would like to see the city develop.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY:

Section I

That the City of Highland Heights, Kentucky through its duly elected Mayor and Council and pursuant to KRS 100.393 hereby formally adopt the statement of goals and policies as presented to them by the City of Highland Heights Planning Commission.

Section II

That the aforementioned goals and policies are hereby adopted as the formal goals and policies in interpreting and using the new updated comprehensive plan of the City of Highland Heights, Kentucky.

Section III

Any Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section IV

That this Ordinance shall be signed by the Mayor, attested by the City Clerk/Treasurer and recorded. Same shall be in effect at the earliest time provided by law.
