ORDINANCE NO. 02-2001

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY
ORDINANCE #11-86, RELATING TO
911 EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SERVICE,
AND INCREASING THE MAXIMUM FEE
TO FUND THE 911 SERVICE TO NOT
MORE THAN \$2.00 PER ACCESS LINE
PER MONTH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY AS
FOLLOWS:

Section I

That Ordinance #11-86, passed by the City Council of the City
of Highland Heights, is hereby amended as follows:

The maximum fee imposed for 911 Emergency Service is hereby
increased from not more than \$.30 per access line per month to not
more than \$2.00 per access line per month.

All other provisions of the above mentioned Ordinance shall
remain unchanged.

Section II


That this Ordinance shall be signed by the Mayor, attested by
the City Clerk/Treasurer and recorded. Same shall be in effect at
the earliest time provided by law.
