ORDINANCE NO. 04-2001

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 16-83 THE OFFICIAL ZONING ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS BY ADDING A NEW SUB-SECTION FOR OFF SITE DIRECTIONAL SIGNS.

WHEREAS, the Highland Heights Planning Commission held a public hearing on February 13, 2001; and,

WHEREAS, said public hearing was held pursuant to KRS 100.207 and 100.211, with all conditions prerequisite thereto being met;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY:

Section I

That Ordinance 16-83 the Highland Heights Zoning Ordinance is amended as follows:

SECTION 14.2.14 Off Site Directional Signs for any business located and operating in Highland Heights are permitted-provided they are included as part of the Streetscape Plan for the US 27 Corridor and are approved by the Planning Commission and City Council. All Off Site Directional Signs shall comply with any sign ordinances or regulations applicable to signs located on or adjacent to State Highways. Signs not proposed on the original Streetscape Plan will require approval of an amendment to the existing Streetscape Plan.

Section II


That this Ordinance shall be signed by the Mayor, attested by the City Clerk/Treasurer recorded and published. Same shall be in effect at the earliest time provided by law.
