ORDINANCE NO. 07-2012

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TEXT OF
ORDINANCE NO. 46-83 COMMONLY REFERRED
TO AS THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS ZONING
ORDINANCE SECTION 14.2.A.3 CONSIDERING
BULLETIN BOARDS AS PERMANENT SIGNAGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY AS
FOLLOWS:

Section I

That a public hearing was held on March 13, 2012 to consider bulletin boards as permanent signage.

Section II

That following the public hearing on this matter the City's Planning and Zoning Commission recommended to the city council that the zoning ordinance be amended as provided below.

Section III

SECTION 14.2.A.3

3. Bulletin board not over twelve (12) square feet in outside area; single or double faced; maximum height of eight (8) feet, for public, charitable or religious institutions when the same is located on the premises of said institutions. Said sign shall be a permanent sign constructed to match the building design and landscaping, shall not be animated, shall not be in the public right of way, may be illuminated but only by concealed lighting, and only until 10:00 P.M

Section IV


