**ORDINANCE NO. 17-2013**

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING  
ORDINANCE NO. 02-2001 AND THE  
PART OF ORDINANCE NO. 11-86  
ESTABLISHING A 911 FEE PER  
PHONE LINE WITHIN THE CITY OF  
HIGHLAND HEIGHTS AS OF  
JANUARY 1<sup>ST</sup>, 2014.

WHEREAS, the County has changed the mechanism to fund 911 emergency service; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Highland Heights will be paying a flat \$45.00 per unit fee for residential or commercial units on parcels of property; and

WHEREAS, it is no longer necessary to have 911 fees attached to our residents' land phone lines.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

That effective January 1, 2014 the portion of Ordinance 11-86 establishing a 911 fee upon phone lines and 02-2001, the ordinance imposing a fee on land telephone lines to fund 911 emergency service is hereby repealed.

Section II


