

CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY
ORDINANCE NO. 09-02

AN ORDINANCE ASSESSING AND
LEVYING AN AD VALOREM TAX ON
THE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY
OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY
AND IMPOSING INTEREST AND
PENALTIES THEREON AND DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY AS
FOLLOWS:

Section I

There shall be and is levied and assessed, an ad valorem tax in the amount of \$1.729 per \$1,000.00 for general fund assessed valuation of all property, real or personal, assessed by the Property Valuation Administrator, reviewed and corrected, altered and returned by the Property Valuation Administrator of the City, also in corporate franchises assessed and returned to said City by the Department of Revenue of the Commonwealth of Kentucky and certified by the State Auditor and State Tax Commissioner, together with any and all other property of any kind or description wherever situated which may be or is subject to taxation for municipal purposes in accordance with the authorities aforesaid.

Section II

That there shall be a 10 percent (10 %) penalty for failure to pay said ad valorem tax within thirty (30) days of the date due and said tax and penalty, if any, shall accrue interest at a rate of percent (12%) per annum from the date due.

Section III

That because the City is so late in getting its tax bills out to the Citizens and because of the difficulty the city has had in getting a quorum to hold a meeting, an emergency is declared suspending the requirements of a second reading and declaring the ordinance effective immediately upon its passage.

Section IV


That this Ordinance shall be signed by the Mayor, attested by the City Clerk/Treasurer and recorded. Same shall be in effect at the earliest time provided by law.

First reading this 19th day of November, 2002.

Passed on 1st reading this 19th day of November, 2002 after council declared an emergency suspending the requirement for a second reading.
