

CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY

ORDINANCE NO. 12-2003

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING WITHIN TWENTY (20) FEET OF CERTAIN DESIGNATED INTERSECTIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

That pursuant to a recommendation from the Police Chief and the Safety Committee for the City of Highland Heights, it is determined that there shall be no parking within twenty (20) feet of certain designated intersections within the City of Highland Heights.

Section II

That the designated intersections prohibiting parking within twenty (20) feet of same shall be clearly marked with signage and/or yellow painting of the curb or both.

Section III

That the penalty for any person cited for disregarding this traffic control device shall be the same as that provided by state law.

Section IV


That this Ordinance shall be signed by the Mayor, attested by the City Clerk/Treasurer and recorded. Same shall be in effect at the earliest time provided by law.
