ORDINANCE NO.09-2004

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN ACCOUNT FOR NON-EMERGENCY UNBUDGETED CAPITAL REPAIR ITEMS.

WHEREAS, the City of Highland Heights established a "Glass Breakage Account" back in 1977 to be used to maintain the skylight in the city building, and

WHEREAS, there was never any legislation passed by the city council to designate the usage of this account, and

WHEREAS, the city council has decided to use that money and any additional money to establish a "non-emergency unbudgeted capital repair fund".

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

That the money currently in the "Glass Breakage Account" \$32,863.32 is now placed in the non-emergency unbudgeted capital repair fund.

Section II

That the money in this account will be restricted to the use of non-emergency unbudgeted capital repair items as determined by the Mayor and the City Council.

Section III

That any ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed as it pertains to the conflict.

Section IV

That this Ordinance shall be signed by the Mayor, attested by the City Clerk/Treasurer and recorded. Same shall be in effect at the earliest time provided by law.
