

CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY

ORDINANCE NO. 15-2005

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS AMENDING CITY ORDINANCE #11-86, ADOPTED ON AUGUST 14, 1986, AND AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 02-2001, ADOPTED FEBRUARY 20, 2001 RELATING TO 911 EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SERVICE, AND INCREASING THE MAXIMUM FEE TO FUND THE 911.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

That Ordinance No. 11-86 adopted by the Highland Heights council on August 14, 1986, and amended by Ordinance No. 02-2001, adopted February 20, 2001, passed by the City Council of the City of Highland Heights, is hereby amended as follows:

The maximum fee imposed for 911 Emergency Service is hereby increased from not more than \$2.00 per access line per month to not more than \$3.30 per access line per month.

All other provisions of Ordinance 02-2001 and Ordinance 11-86 shall remain unchanged.

Section II


That this Ordinance shall be signed by the Mayor, attested by the City Clerk/Treasurer and recorded. Same shall be in effect at the earliest time provided by law.
