

CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY

ORDINANCE NO. 01-2006

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING NO PARKING
ON HIGH STREET FROM THE INTERSECTION OF
US 27 AND HIGH STREET FOR ONE HUNDRED
FIFTY (150) FEET ON THE EAST AND WEST SIDES
OF HIGH STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY AS
FOLLOWS:

Section I

That pursuant to recommendations of the Board of Adjustments and Chief of Police for the City of Highland Heights, a no parking zone is established on High Street from the Intersection of US 27 and High Street and the east and west side of High Street for a distance of One Hundred Fifty (150) feet.

Section II

That appropriate signage and yellow painting of the curb shall be installed immediately after passage of this Ordinance.

Section III


That the penalty for any persons cited under this Ordinance shall be the same as the penalty set forth in Section 72.99 of the City's Code of Ordinances. Ten (\$10.00) per violation and an additional Ten (\$10.00) if fines are not paid within seven (7) days.

Section IV

That this ordinance shall be signed by the Mayor, attested by the City Clerk/Treasurer, recorded and published according to law. Same shall be in effect at the earliest time provided by law.
