# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE NO PARKING LOCATIONS SCHEDULE IN THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES.

This ordinance amends Chapter 75 of the Highland Heights Code of Ordinances Schedule I: No Parking Locations of the City of Highland Heights Code of Ordinances to designate the following area on Rose Avenue and Maple Avenue as a no parking location: beginning at the intersection of US 27 with the north curb line at Rose Avenue for a distance of 32 feet. Further at the intersection of US 27 with the north curb line at Maple Avenue for a distance of 32 feet. The other areas listed as no parking locations in Schedule I remain unchanged.

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE NO PARKING LOCATIONS SCHEDULE IN THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

#### Section I

That Chapter § 75, Schedule I: No Parking Locations of the City of Highland Heights Code of Ordinances, Ordinance 11-88, and Ordinance 02-2020 are amended as follows:

## § 75 SCHEDULE I: NO PARKING LOCATIONS

Knollwood Drive	On the north and south side entering into the Knollwood Subdivision at
	the intersection of Martha Layne, Johns Hill and Knollwood Drive for
	approximately 150 feet
Linet	West side at the north end and at a point 62 feet south of the first sign
Old U.S. 27	East side adjacent to 1954 and 1962 Alexandria Pike for approximately 25
	feet
Ridge Hill Drive	On the odd numbered side
Rose Avenue	Beginning at the intersection of US 27 with the north curb line at Rose
	Avenue for a distance of 32 feet
Maple Avenue	Beginning at the intersection of US 27 with the north curb line at Maple
	Avenue for a distance of 32 feet.
Singleton Avenue	East and west sides, from Taylor to corner of Singleton and U.S. 27
Taylor Avenue	East and west sides, from Main to corner of Taylor and U.S. 27
Wilson east of	North side at the east and west ends

Wilson east of	South side at the intersection and at a point 64 feet from the center of
