

**CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS
MUNICIPAL AID ROAD FUND
PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES
MAY 1, 2018**

On Tuesday, May 1, 2018 Mayor Meyers called the Municipal Aid Road Fund Public Hearing to order at 176 Johns Hill Road at 7:00 p.m.

PRESENT: Mayor Gregory Meyers, Council Members: Jeanne Pettit, Deborah Ball, Gary Chinn, Dave Ramler, John Hoffert and A.J. Moermond.

Also present: City Attorney Steve Franzen, City Engineer/Zoning Administrator Dave Whitacre, Public Works Supervisor Steve Lehman, Police Chief Bill Birkenhauer and City Clerk Treasurer/Recording Secretary Jean Rauf.

Mayor Meyers announced the purpose of the Public Hearing is to receive comments and discuss the proposed use of Municipal Aid Road Funds for Fiscal Year 2018-2019.

NOTIFICATION PROCESS: Mrs. Rauf announced that Notice of the MARF Public Hearing meeting was published in the Campbell County Recorder on April 19, 2018. Notice was posted on the front door of the City Building and City Website.

MAYORS PRESENTATION: Mayor Meyers announced the City has \$140,000.00 to spend on repairs for the roads. Mayor Meyers turned it over to the Infrastructure Committee for comments.

COMMENTS FROM COUNCIL: Member Ramler gave a report of streets that need road repairs. He stated that he and Member Chinn drove the streets. They gave a brief informational report on the following streets. The report is attached to the minutes.

- #1. Jillian Drive panel joints and holes.
- #2. Catherine Court in need of panel joints repair.
- #3. Towanda Drive in need of repair in bend around the manhole cover.
- #4. Honeytree Lane panels in circle need repair.
- #5. Ridge Hill Drive holes along the 200 block need repair.
- #6. Knollwood Drive in the 409 area holes.
- #7. Forest Ave. left and right side need repairs.
- #8. Alexandria Way holes near city BBQ.
- #9. Sunset Drive holes up and down street.
- #10. Chalon Lane hole near stop sign.
- #11. Louisville Road holes and rough
- #12. Dale Road is rough at the beginning.

Member Pettit asked about the overlay on Alexandria Way or just repair the holes. City Engineer/Zoning Administrator Dave Whitacre addressed the issue and will check on it.

Member Ball commented on the heavily traveled Sunset Drive. She reported she knows that it is on the list; but the center of this street is rough.

Mayor Meyers reported he will see that the City Engineer/Zoning Administrator Dave Whitacre receives the list of streets recommended for repairs.

CORRESPONDENCE: None.

CITIZENS COMMENTS: Julie Cundiff, 116 Thompson stated concerns about the parking on Hale and Thompson. Another citizen has concerns about the condition of Hale off of Bramble. After considerable discussion about this matter, Mayor Meyer referred it to the Safety Committee and the Police Chief for review.
