

**CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS
MUNICIPAL AID ROAD FUND
PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES
MAY 2, 2017**

On Tuesday, May 2, 2017 Mayor Meyers called the Municipal Aid Road Fund Public Hearing to order at 176 Johns Hill Road at 7:00 p.m.

PRESENT: Mayor Gregory Meyers, Council Members: Deborah Ball, Gary Chinn, Dave Ramler, John Hoffert and A.J. Moermond.

Also present: City Attorney Steve Franzen, City Engineer/Zoning Administrator Dave Whitacre, Public Works Supervisor Steve Lehman, Police Chief Bill Birkenhauer and City Clerk Treasurer/Recording Secretary Jean Rauf.

ABSENT: Jeanne Pettit.

Mayor Meyers announced the purpose of the Public Hearing is to receive comments and discuss the proposed use of Municipal Air Road Funds for Fiscal Year 2017-2018.

NOTIFICATION PROCESS: Mrs. Rauf announced that Notice of the MARF Public Hearing meeting was published in the Campbell County Recorder on April 20, 2017. Notice was posted on the front door of the City Building.

MAYORS PRESENTATION: Mayor Meyers announced the City has \$140,000.00 to spend on repairs for the roads. Mayor Meyers turned it over to the Infrastructure Committee for comments.

COMMENTS FROM COUNCIL: Member Ramler gave a report of streets that need road repairs. He stated that he and Member Chinn drove the streets. They gave a brief informational report on the following streets:

- #1. Tesseneer Drive in need of repair and overlay.
- #2. Forest Ave. in need of repair and overlay.
- #3. Louisville, Hale (off Bramble) and Deitrich Road in need of repair and overlay.
- #4. Sunset Drive in need of repair and overlay.
- #5. Jillian Ct. and Jillian Ct. at the Knollwood intersection in need of repair on panel joints and holes.
- #6. Towanda Drive panel replacement at manhole cover.
- #7. Honey Tree Lane panel joints.
- #8. Katherine Court panel joints getting bad.

Member Moermond asked about the drainage issue on the wall at Wilson Ave. After a brief discussion, Mayor Meyers will add the drainage issue to the list for consideration.


CORRESPONDENCE: None.
