## CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY ORDINANCE NO. 02-2020

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE NO PARKING LOCATIONS SCHEDULE IN THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES.
