

**CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY  
ORDINANCE NO. 02-2020**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE NO PARKING  
LOCATIONS SCHEDULE IN THE CITY CODE OF  
ORDINANCES.**

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HEIGHTS,  
CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:**

Section I

That Chapter § 75, Schedule I: No Parking Locations of the City of Highland Heights Code of Ordinances and Ordinance 11-88 is amended as follows:

**§ 75 SCHEDULE I: NO PARKING LOCATIONS**

STREET	LOCATION
[Abby] Ridge Hill [Road] Drive	On the odd numbered side
[Delco Center's main building (K-Mart)]	[Beginning at the north corner and continuing along the immediate front of the entire shopping complex to the existing general customer parking area]
[Delco Center's main building (K-Mart)]	[Along the entire north side of the building]
Hilltop Drive	On either the east or west side starting at the city boundary line and running to the corner of Hilltop and Knollwood Drive
Knollwood Drive	On the north and south side entering into the Knollwood Subdivision at the intersection of Martha Layne, Johns Hill and Knollwood Drive for approximately 150 feet
Linnet	West side at the north end and at a point 62 feet south of the first sign
[Marshall Lane]	[At the easterly side of lot 166 (124 Marshall) and the westerly side of lot 167]
Old U.S. 27	East side adjacent to 1954 and 1962 Alexandria Pike for approximately 25 feet
Singleton Avenue	East and west sides, from Taylor to corner of Singleton and U.S. 27
Taylor Avenue	East and west sides, from Main to corner of Taylor and U.S. 27
Wilson east of Bramble	North side at the east and west ends
Wilson east of Bramble	South side at the intersection and at a point 64 feet from the center of Bramble

Section II

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, approval and publication as is required by law.
