Pursuant to KRS 132.027, the City of Highland Heights will hold its Public Hearing on Tuesday, September 1, 2026 at 6:45 p.m. The public hearing will be held at the City Building, 176 Johns Hill Road, Highland Heights, KY 41076, for the purpose of hearing comments from the public regarding the institution of the 2026 proposed tax rate.

The City of Highland Heights proposes to exceed the compensating rate by levying a real property tax rate of 0.149 (per \$100.00 of assessed value) and a personal property tax rate of 0.149 (per \$100.00 of assessed value). The excess revenue generated will be utilized for the following purposes: assist with the City's contributions to the pension, increases in fuel costs, higher insurance premiums, and increases in the costs for street repairs and replacement.
